Hi my name is Aleksandar Obrenovic, my father Captain Branislav Z Obrenovic was a Serbian Officer in this POW camp and I am very interested in finding out more from the history he told me when he was alive, I have pictures and a lot of things from the camp like is personal TAG of KG # 541, money from the third Reich.

He tell me that General's Patton son in law was at the Camp and that in the first intent a Tank was destroyed and left by the Germans without permission to buried the soldiers that were burned and dead, they left them so they could see the defeat and not to gain courage and hopes of freedom, he commanded a Serbian group of officers and got permission from the Germans to do a burial of this sine men that die.

He then signed as a volunteer with General's Patton 12th Division. He also save his life, I have Patton's Zippo lighter given to my father in appreciation
